

Missouri Winery Passport Program and Tasting Journal

FAQs:

How does the stamp and code work?

Both the stamp and code are needed to validate passports online. Each winery received a stamp and a Passport Display, their unique code is printed ON the display package. Record the winery code in your passport and ask the winery staff to stamp your passport.

What does one have to do to earn a stamp?

Although we recommend it, no purchase or tasting is required to earn a stamp. To participate one must simply present the passport in the tasting room to earn a stamp and receive the winery code.

Are all wineries in Missouri participating in the program?

While most wineries are eligible, not all are participating in the program. Please see the list of wineries not participating at <http://www.missouriwine.org/intro-stamp-page>.

Can a person have more than one passport?

Yes, if someone fills up their passport or forgets their passport at home they may start a new passport. Reward redemption is determined online where passports may be combined to reach a particular level. **However, only one account per person is allowed.** If an individual is using multiple accounts, the Missouri Wine and Grape Board will delete all but one.

Can I visit the same winery twice?

No, one stamp per winery is allowed. We want you to experience all that The Country's First Wine Country has to offer.

Is the program cumulative?

Yes, if a participant goes all the way through the program and reaches Level 7 they will have received all of the rewards. There is **no** need to wait to redeem all of your codes at once to receive a higher reward. Visit our [Winery Passport and Tasting Journal](#) page for a list of rewards gained at each level.

How do I enter my codes and stamps?

First go to the passport page, <http://www.missouriwine.org/intro-stamp-page>, and log in using the username and password you created. If you have not created an account, you need to do so. Once logged in, type in your winery code (one at a time) and then click on "Look Up Code" to the right of the code. Once you enter your code, a selection of stamps will appear. Select the corresponding stamp and then click on "Add." You will then be prompted to enter your next stamp and follow the steps above until you have entered all of them.

Can a participant get credit for previous winery visits?

No, you must have your passport stamped and record the winery code at the time of your winery visit.

When does this promotion expire?

There is currently not an end date on this program or time restrictions for redeeming rewards. The Missouri Wine and Grape Board reserves the right to cancel the program without notice.
