

Below are instructions and guidelines on how to use your Missouri Winery Passport & Tasting Journal. Enjoy your tour of Missouri Wine Country, The Country's First Wine Country.

1. Once you have obtained a Winery Passport & Tasting Journal, please visit a Missouri winery and locate the Winery Passport & Tasting Journal display posted in the visitor area of the winery or talk to a winery representative for on-site instructions. The display features a *stamp and a code* that is specific to the individual winery. Mark your passport with the stamp and code in the space provided on one of the destination pages inside your booklet.
2. When you have visited at least *four* wineries and entered the code from each destination (one entry per sheet), log on to [www.missouriwine.org](http://www.missouriwine.org). Click on the *Winery Passport & Tasting Journal* tab, create an account and enter the codes and stamps from your passport. After providing your contact information, your reward will be shipped to you, courtesy of the Missouri Wine and Grape Board (MWGB). Note: only one account per person is allowed.
3. Once you have visited four wineries and filled the spaces in your passport, continue to fill out your existing passport or begin a new passport to earn additional rewards. Ask for your free Winery Passport & Tasting Journal at any Missouri winery or order one at [www.missouriwine.org](http://www.missouriwine.org). Completed passports can be collected and used to track your winery visits and note your favorite Missouri wines.
4. Once you surpass redemption Level 4 (20 winery visits), you will be provided only *one reward per address based on the levels determined*.
5. Rewards for Levels 5, 6 & 7 will be awarded based on availability and winery commitment. You may still enter your winery stamps and codes each time you reach a milestone, and your reward will be sent to you once the level of required participation is met. ***Rewards will not be chosen by the passport holder, but will be presented in the order and date in which the wineries commit.***
6. Rewards are based on availability, season and winery participation. In the case of rewards provided directly to the passport holder by a participating winery, the reward winner and the participating winery will be responsible for any necessary scheduling. All taxes, fees and surcharges on prizes, along with any applicable gratuities, are the sole responsibility of the reward winner(s). Although the MWGB will attempt to ensure that every passport holder receives his or her reward, the passport holder acknowledges and recognizes that participating wineries may withdraw rewards without notice as a result of economic or other factors. While the MWGB will attempt to reschedule such events with another participating winery, the passport holder acknowledges and agrees that neither MWGB nor the participating wineries have any liability, legal duty or responsibility to the passport holder.
7. Cancellation of the wine and food pairing for 10 within 72 hours of the scheduled pairing will result in a loss of the reward and will not be rescheduled.
8. Rewards are non-transferable and may be redeemed only by the passport holder. Rewards may not be substituted.
9. Once you have visited 95 wineries and completed the passport program, you may not go through the program again for credit or rewards; however we encourage you to continue visiting our many wineries.
10. No cash awards will be provided, either directly or in lieu of, or as a substitute for rewards under the program.
11. By participating in the Winery Passport & Tasting Journal program, the passport holder agrees to cooperate with MWGB. MWGB may publicize and use information, data, conclusions, articles, reports, brochures, audio and videotapes, photographs and other items related to, or in connection with, the passport holder's participation in the program. By participating in the program, the passport holder gives MWGB the right and authority to release any information related to a passport holder's participation in the Winery Passport & Tasting Journal program, unless otherwise prohibited by law. The passport holder consents to the use of his or her name and photograph or video for publicity, promotion and advertising purposes, in all media and formats used by MWGB, without further compensation, throughout the world, in perpetuity. By entering, participants and passport holders agree to release and hold harmless MWGB, its commissioner, assistant commissioners, directors, officers, employees, agents and advisors, and assigns from any and all liability, injuries, loss or damage of any kind arising out of participation in the program, or in connection with the receipt or use of any award provided under the program.

12. MWGB's decision as to all matters related to the administration of the program and selection of award recipients are final. Participants must comply with all these terms and conditions set forth.
13. MWGB reserves the right to cancel or modify the Winery Journal program without notice.
14. MWGB assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, disruption or delay of the postal service or other delivery service.
15. There is no purchase necessary to participate in the Missouri Winery Passport & Tasting Journal program.
16. The Winery Passport program does not create any debt on behalf of the State of Missouri and/or MWGB in violation of Section 49 Article III of the Missouri Constitution. In compliance with Section 6, Article III, of the Missouri Constitution, all obligations of the State of Missouri or MWGB hereunder, if any, are subject to the availability of appropriations and authorization to pay by the Missouri Legislature.
